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Notes: The title given for a bishop or archbishop is the last which he held. Where a peer of the realm held more than one title mentioned in this study, the one provided below is that by which he is best known.

Charles II, James II, William III, Mary II and George I are mentioned so frequently throughout this text, they are not generally cited in the index. Rather, the reader is encouraged to look for the event itself or person most involved with that event to find the relevant pages of this study. The same is true for terms such as 'Dissenter', 'Presbyterian', and their ilk.

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
